Policy Reminder:



During the past 24 hours we have had several of Miss Christie's students come down with a stomach bug. With the H1N1 virus spreading and other illness going around it's so important to keep our staff and students healthy! Below is an excerpt from the 2009-2010 MSYC Parent Handbook. Please take the time to read this information (particularly the parts in **bold.**) This can be found on page 19 of your handbook.

If your child becomes ill at home with any of the following, he/she should not attend school:

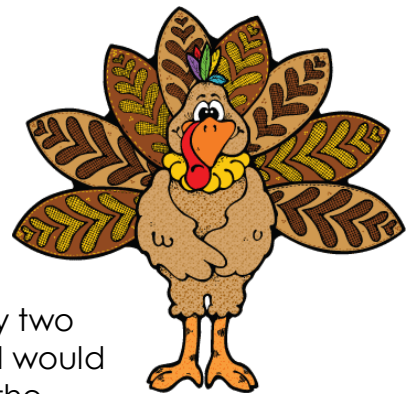
- fever of 100 degrees or more
- diarrhea
- vomiting
- rash
- chicken pox
- ringworm
- impetigo
- head lice
- pink eye
- other communicable viruses/diseases

Please call the school and let them know that your child will not be attending due to illness. If your child has a communicable disease/virus, let our staff know so we may inform the other parents in the school. If your child will be on medication upon returning to school, please notify the staff. **Your child must be free of fever for 24 hours before returning to the classroom or you place other students and our staff at risk of infection. Children with diarrhea (2 or more watery stools within 24 hours) or vomiting should not return until they are free of symptoms for 24 hours.**
