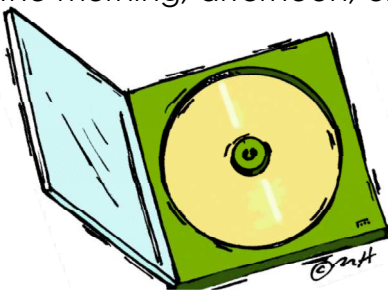
## Just a reminder...

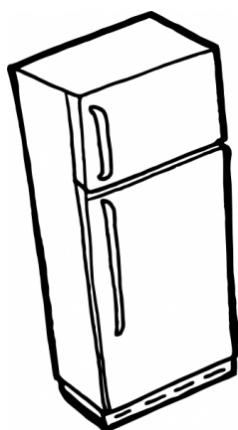
## Spanish CDs to be available Monday!!!

eggs in shell	4 - 5 w
Cheese Products	1 w
Hot dogs	1 - 2 w
Leafy lettuce	3 - 7 d
Cabbage lettuce	1 - 2 w
Uncooked meats:	2 w
Opened:	3 - 5 d
Uncooked meat & pork	3 - 5 d
Uncooked poultry & fish, uncooked sausage, leftover gravy, or meat broth	1 - 2 d
Uncooked poultry	3 - 4 d
